Squash Handicap Tournament 2008

RULES

1. All starting times are estimates due to the nature of the game. Players are advised to be at the courts at least 10 min. before the allocated time.

A player who fails to enter the court within two (2) minutes after a call to start is made will concede a walkover.

A two (2) minutes interval is allowed between each game and three (3) minutes for a "rubber".

2. Each game is played based on the American scoring system, i.e. every point counts and played to fifteen (15) points. Whoever reaches 15 points first wins the game. There will be no deuce at 14-all.
3. The following shall be played to the best of five (5) games.
 - i. Open Event Finals.
 - ii. Plate (OPEN) Finals.

All other matches are played to the best of 3 games.

4. Handicaps awarded by the Organizing Committee are final.

If a player with a positive handicap plays a player with a negative handicap, both players start from their awarded handicap

When players have a negative/positive handicap, the one with handicap closer to 0 will start at 0 and the other will start with the appropriate difference in handicap. Example: Player A has -5 and player B has -3; in this case player B will start at 0 and player A will start at -2 (Difference between -5 and -3 = -2)

5. Towel placement courtside is allowed.
6. Maximum time between points to towel off is 30 sec
7. Official Ball: Prince.
8. All disputes will be referred to the Organizing Committee whose decision will be final.
